



### **Part 1—Sin and Death Enters the World**

Read Romans 5:12; Genesis 1:31; Genesis 3:1-7

- 1) According to this verse in Romans what is the cause of death in the world, and what is the cause of death's "cause"?
- 2) According to Genesis 1 and 3 do you think God is responsible for death and sin?
- 3) Why do you think many people blame God for evil and suffering? Why is this unjust?

### **Part 2—All Have Sinned**

Read Romans 5:12; Romans 3:19-23

- 1) According to this verse why is the human death rate 100%? Is that fair?
- 2) According to Romans 3 why is it important that "ALL Have Sinned"?
- 3) How do you think all people "became" sinners?

### **Part 3—Sin Present With or Without the Law**

Read Romans 5:13-14; Genesis 6:5-6

- 1) How do we know people are sinners if they have no law of God to break?
- 2) According to Genesis 6 how could God judge the world for their sin with a flood if there were no laws for them to break?
- 3) How does this truth affect people in remote places who have no Bibles and no 10 commandments?

### **Part 4—Two Representatives**

Read Romans 5:12-14; 1 Corinthians 15:21-22

- 1) According to this verse how was Adam a type of the coming Christ?
- 2) According to 1 Corinthians 15 how do both Adam and Christ serve as our representatives?
- 3) How does Adam's effect on you pave the way for Christ's effect?
