- 3) Why does Romans 5:18 NOT teach the universal salvation of all?

### **Part 2—Made Sinners or Made Righteous**

Read Romans 5:19; 1 Peter 2:5-10

- 1) What do you think are the effects of being “made sinners” in contrast to being “made righteous”?
- 2) According to 1 Peter 2 how does the work of God inside us change how we act on the outside?
- 3) How does Adam's disobedience affect you, and how does Jesus obedience affect you TODAY?

### **Part 3—Maximizing the Effect**

Read Romans 5:20; Romans 3:19-20

- 1) How does the Law maximize the effect of sin?
- 2) How does the Law maximize the effect of grace?
- 3) How might this verse affect the way you share the gospel with others?

### **Part 4—Reigning Through Righteousness**

Read Romans 5:21; Romans 5:17; 2 Peter 1:1-4

- 1) How do you think God's grace reigns “through righteousness” in the Christian's life?
- 2) According to 2 Peter 1 what part does righteousness play in the Christian's life?
- 3) In what practical ways do you see grace reigning through righteousness in your life?
