



### **Part 1—A Logical Case**

Read Romans 6:6-7; Galatians 5:24-25

- 1) According to these verses, what enables the Christian to ignore the demands of sin?
- 2) According to Galatians 5, what are the given facts of those who belong to Christ?
- 3) Leaving your personal experience aside, does the logic of this “freedom from sin” make sense to you in theory? Why?

### **Part 2—Believe It Or Not**

Read Romans 6:8; Mark 9:21-24

- 1) According to this verse what part does faith (belief) play in our new life as Christians?
- 2) In Mark 9 what does Jesus indicate was the greatest hindrance to the boy’s healing? Why do you think that is?
- 3) How does a lack of faith hinder your victory over sin?

### **Part 3—No More Authority**

Read Romans 6:9; Philippians 2:8; Acts 2:22-24

- 1) How did death have dominion over Jesus; and how does it have dominion over us?
- 2) According to Acts 2, why do you suppose it was impossible for Jesus to remain in the grave?
- 3) How could your identity with Jesus’ resurrection give you confidence when facing sin?

### **Part 4—Life After Death**

Read Romans 6:10; Revelation 1:17-18

- 1) How does time relate to both Jesus’ death and resurrection?
- 2) According to Revelation 1 how does Christ’s death affect Him today?
- 3) What aspect of the Gospel should you most identify with (by baptism-vs.4) today? Why?
